Book in a Box:

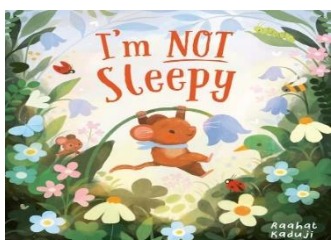
