




Costume Ideas:

Paddington Bear






For this, you just need a raincoat, an old bag/suitcase and a hate (ideally red).

A dalmation from 101 Dalmations






For this, you just need a white t-shirt, which you can dot with a black pen. If you have paint, you could paint your nose black.








For this, you would need a white t-shirt and black shorts. You can accessorise it with some trainers and a black backpack!
