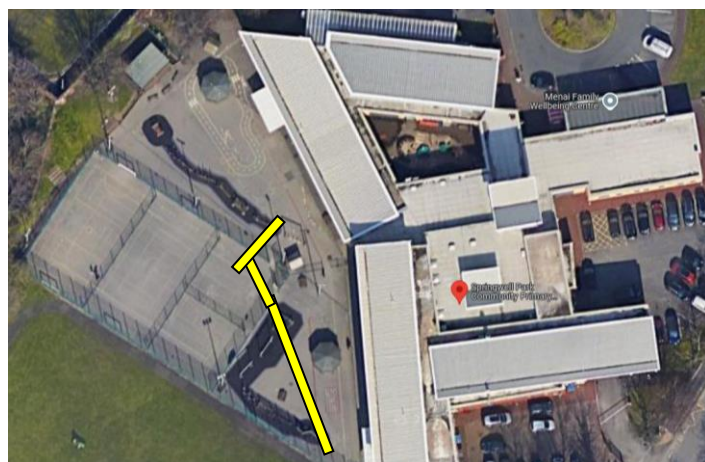
### **Change of exit for Year 6**

During Covid, we started to utilise the exit that leads onto the Children's Centre carpark due to social distancing. Now that the centre is fully operational, and social distancing is no longer required, we are reducing the number of children leaving via this exit. Due to this, Y6 children will now exit the school through the side door that the children enter through of a morning. Year 4 will continue exiting through the Children's Centre exit as normal, for the time being.

All other exits for the children remain the same, with Year 6 being the only change.

### **Reception and Nursery Request**

In order to ease congestion, we are kindly requesting for parents of our reception and nursery children to enter the Key-Stage 2 playground as normal, but enter and exit the Key-stage 1/EYFS playground via the football cages. This will enable years 3 and 5 staff to dismiss their children more efficiently. Please see the illustration to the right for a visual – the yellow being the desired path to collect your children.



Once you have collected your children, please do aim to leave the playground promptly.
