School uniform

It is really important that all children wear the correct school uniform. Please see below for our expectations;

School uniform

- Plain white polo shirt
- Purple cardigan/sweatshirt with the school logo
- Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore
- Grey shorts
- Black shoes *
- Purple gingham/striped dress (summer only)

*children are allowed to wear all black trainers. This includes the sole of the shoe.

Colourful trainers or trainers with white / coloured markings and soles are not allowed.

PE kit

All children will wear their PE kit to school on their PE day.

The PE kits is;

- Purple t-shirt with the school logo
- Black shorts
- Black pumps

In colder weather the children can wear their school jumper over their t-shirt and plain black tracksuit bottoms over their shorts.

Alternatively, there is an optional school tracksuit. This consists of black tracksuit bottoms and a black hooded jacket with the school logo on. (No sports clothing)

Jewellery

Permitted jewellery that may be worn is:

- One pair of stud earrings
- A smart and sensible wrist watch. (Smart watches eg Apple watches must not be worn in school)

Jewellery is the responsibility of the pupil and not the school. Lost or damaged items will not be refunded. All jewellery must be removed during practical lessons, including PE lessons and science experiments.

Nails

- False nails and nail varnish are not allowed

All pupils' clothing and footwear needs to be clearly labelled with the pupil's name. This year we have had a huge number of jumpers and coats in lost property with no name.
