



# Meet Your Digital Leaders...





**Role Definition** - A Digital Leader is a pupil who excels in computing and is able to use their skills to lead the digital world.

	What difference will you make to Springwell by being a Digital Leader?	"I will help to make our school even more safe."


	<b>Maggie, Year 1</b>
