Children are democratically voted for Digital Leaders and Reading Leaders. Children vote for their next class text. Year 2 children are familiar with the classroom rules. Year 2 children receive golden tickets and FAB50 trip, as well as reflection for negative behaviour. Year 2 receive visits from the local PCSO. In Autumn 1 within Computing, Year 2 focus on E-Safety. In Autumn 1 within PSHE, Year 2 focus on 'Why Do We Have Rules?'. Year 2 children are aware of the classroom and school rules, including the need of showing each other respect. In Autumn 1 within RE, Year 2 children focus on 'How Should We Care for Others and The World, and Why Does It Matter?'. In Autumn 2 within PSHE, Year 2 children focus on Caring Friendships. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children receive a whole school assembly all about Tolerance. Our books in our Year 2 library are diverse. In Autumn 1 within RE, our Year 2 children focus on 'Why Do We Celebrate Hannukah?'. In Autumn 2 within PSHE, our Year 2 children focus on 'Tolerance of Others'. In Spring 1 within RE, our Year 2 children focus on 'Who Is Jewish and What Do They Believe?'. In Spring 2 within RE, our Year 2 children focus on Who Is Muslim and What Do They Believe?'. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The children receive a whole school assembly all about Individual Liberty.
