Dear Parents/Carers,

By working together, we can ensure that children across our whole community benefit from a clear and consistent approach to behaviour.

We know that children thrive when school and home work in partnership, so we are asking for your support. By reinforcing the same messages together, we can help our children make positive choices, respect one another, and make the most of every learning opportunity.

How We Can Work Together

Respect and Courtesy

Parents and carers are expected to:

- Treat all members of the school community (pupils, staff and other parents) with respect, courtesy, and kindness.
- Communicate with teachers and staff in a calm and constructive manner.
- Avoid using offensive, threatening, or aggressive language or behaviour.
- Talk to your child about the importance of good behaviour, respect, and following school rules.

Communication

- Use appropriate channels such as emails, phone calls, scheduled meetings to communicate with teachers, pastoral or admin. We also have teachers available at the end of the day and the pastoral team are on the gate in the morning and end of the day.
- Allow reasonable time for staff to respond to messages
- Avoid discussing school matters or individuals on social media; instead, raise concerns directly and privately with the school.

Supporting learning

- Ensure your child attends school regularly and on time.
- Support school policies on uniform and behaviour.

- Read regularly with your child. We have noticed a significant decline in the number of children reading at home. Reading is the biggest indicator of future success.
- Foster a positive attitude toward education and the school community at home.
- Work in partnership with teachers to support your child's learning and well-being.

Our school is committed to creating a safe, respectful, and positive learning environment for all students, staff, and families. By working together — parents, carers, and school staff — we can create a consistent, supportive environment that allows every child to succeed academically, socially, and emotionally.
