Coming up: SATs

Next week, our Year 6 pupils will be taking part in their SATs (Standard Assessment Tests). These are national assessments that help measure children's progress and attainment at the end of Key Stage 2, focusing on subjects such as reading, grammar, punctuation, spelling and mathematics.

The tests will take place throughout the week, with each paper scheduled in the mornings. We aim to keep the environment calm and supportive so that all pupils feel confident and ready to do their best.

It is particularly important that children come to school well rested each day. A good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast can make a big difference in helping them stay focused and perform at their best.

SATs are a great opportunity for pupils to show all that they have learned during their time in primary school. We are very proud of how hard they have worked.
