Dear Parents and Carers,

As we continue to experience periods of hot weather, we would like to reassure you that the safety and wellbeing of all children remains our priority. We are following the latest guidance from the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) and the Department for Education to help keep children safe and comfortable during warmer temperatures.

To reduce the risk of heat-related illness, we will be:

- Encouraging children to drink water regularly throughout the day.
- Providing opportunities to refill water bottles as needed.
- Opening windows and doors before the start of the day to allow ventilation in the building
- Keeping classrooms as cool as possible by closing blinds and curtains where appropriate
- Planning outdoor activities for cooler parts of the day where possible.
- Reducing time outside at lunchtime
- PE and sports after school clubs will occur inside with reduced movement
- Monitoring children for signs of heat exhaustion and responding promptly if concerns arise.
- Encouraging children to wear summer uniform; summer dresses or polo shirt and shorts

Please support us by ensuring that your child:

- Brings a clearly named water bottle to school every day
- Wears appropriate summer clothing in line with the school uniform policy
- Has a high factor sunscreen on
- Brings a named sun hat or cap
- Leaves their school sweatshirt and coat at home

We will continue to monitor weather forecasts and follow national guidance. Should temperatures rise significantly, we may introduce additional measures and will keep you informed.

Thank you for your support in helping us keep all children safe and comfortable during the warmer weather.
